

Freshly updated, Beeton Hall Events Centre is a cluster of four spaces: Beeton Hall, Executive Boardroom, Founders' Room and Sonnet. Ideal for small to medium size meetings or conferences. The Centre features a reception lobby, private washrooms, a cloak room, catering kitchen, and an optional private entrance from Collier Street. A combination of contemporary wood paneling and exposed brick bring sophisticated elegance to any event.



Beeton Hall

Capacity: 180 people

Epic Hall

Capacity: 458 people

Epic Hall is the largest of the three Appel Salon rooms. It has an open floor plan with a built-in stage and features dramatic windows along the east and north side, a private outdoor terrace, exposed brick and contemporary wood panel walls.

Capacity: up to 250 people




