


Who We Are



With fabulous photography locations featuring naturescapes, heritage buildings, and vintage cars and farm equipment, your happily ever after will be framed with country charm and elegance.



The Clark-McCleary *House*

(Formerly The General Store) Available late May - Mid September Capacity: 280 guests







The Puslinch Town Hall

Available year round

A traditional barn, this open post and beam structure surrounds you with welcoming warmth radiating from the reclaimed wood, simple elegance and overwhelming natural beauty. Carefully lit hewn beams and twinkle lights create the perfect atmosphere for any event. The Barn's unique name reflects the roof style, and it was built in 1984 as a Bi-Centennial celebration project.

Included with the rental of the Gambrel Barn is the Gambrel Loft area. this area can hold seating for up to 60 people as a ceremony site, or can be used as a bridal suite/wedding party only area. It is accessible only by stairs and overlooks the main Gambrel Barn area.



At Country Heritage Park we truly want to make your vision come to life, and we're happy to customize each wedding or celebration package with each couple. Customizations may or may not be charged an additional fee, however any additional charges will be fully disclosed to each booking party and discussed before adding to any contract. Additions to enhance the wonderful celebration of your day could include:

- * A guided tour of Country Heritage Park's beautiful 80 acres by one of our dedicated educators, transportation provided on one of our dedicated tractor wagons (accessible options available). Your guests will be able to see the beauty of the park, learn about the history of our Park, and Ontario's agriculture. This guided tour can be of just the Park itself, or can include stops at any of our 19 heritage buildings on site, including our 1910 School House, 1860s Farmstead, 1890s General Store and 1880s Blacksmith shop. (no alcohol permitted on wagons)
- + Within our beautiful 80 acres we have many outdoor picnic and celebration areas!

 Many couples choose to host rehearsal dinners, Mendhi ceremonies, bridal retreats and more.

 Embrace the country charm and highlight the natural beauty of your celebration and our landscape!
- + Entertain your guests and impart a little bit of knowledge and cool facts with our live historic interpretations. Your guests can experience some of our most popular buildings with a tractor wagon tour and costumed educators providing conversation and neat photo-ops! Choose from any of our heritage buildings to give guests that insta-reel they won't want to miss!
- + Add-on a walking tour of our site, with a dedicated guide, to get the blood flowing and experience every step of our 80 acre site. From the 1830s farmstead to our current farming operations, there's something to pique everyone's interest with the appropriate footwear of course!
- + For a real country feel, add transportation from the parking lot to your ceremony or reception site, with our tractor wagon rides. We have options for accessible wagons, and can seat up to 50 on our largest wagon. Have your guests ride in true high fashion and set the party mood for your celebration! (no alcohol permitted on wagons)
- + Want to extend the party? Add pre- or post- wedding activities and tours for your guests, bridal party or just family! From historic tours, to team building, to gardening and giving back to local charities, we can facilitate any experience you can envision!

Country Heritage Park provides 2 Smart Serve certified bartenders for every +50 guests, up to 4 total.

Country Heritage Park provides plastic barware to guests. If you would prefer glass drinkware, it must be provided by and coordinated with an external vendor.

No outside alcohol. All alcohol onsite must be supplied through CHP's Liquor License. Alcoholic shots are not permitted.

Any and all alcohol sold, served and consumed must be provided through Bar Service, provided by Country Heritage Park. Specialty orders of alcoholic beverages may be accommodated with appropriate notice, and may add extra fees (IE Preferred beers, wines and liquors). If guests are found to be consuming alcohol not provided by Country Heritage Park, staff can and will ask the guest to vacate the premises. This is a legal requirement of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario and the Halton Police Service.

Venue reservations are considered on a first come, first served basis. Reservations will be held for 7 days following the issuing of a contract. After 14 days, a 50% non-refundable Event Deposit must be made, and the contract signed and returned to Country Heritage Park.

Methods of Payment	Interac / Visa / Mastercard E-transfer to taylor@countryheritagepark.com
Venue Access	Couples, external vendors and guests will have access to the booked reception venue as of 9:00 am on the day of the booking until 2:00 am.
Parking	Ample free parking available. If two events are booked, a separate lot will be designated for each location. Vehicles are permitted to remain overnight however must be picked up the following day between 9:00 am - 12:00 pm. Booking parties will pay a flat rate fee for any cars remaining from their event past the pick-up window.
Inclement Weather	In the event of inclement weather, Country Heritage Park will connect with the Booking Party or designated representative as soon as possible. All outdoor ceremony sites have contingency plans available, if needed.
Cancellation Policy	Cancellation of the booking by the client will result in forfeiture of the 50% paid deposit.
Exclusivity Policy	Country Heritage Park could, at any point, have multiple events taking place in a single day as we are a multi-use facility. Therefore, at no point does any one applicant or event have exclusivity of the entire park, other than the contracted venue/building and the proximity of the exterior.
Additional Fees Paid to Country Heritage Park	Besides your ceremony and/or reception rental the following are additional fees: • Bar Package • SoCan/Resound Tariff Music License Fee • Any optional upgrades or add-ons chosen
Audio-Visual / Wi-Fi	Country Heritage Park is happy to provide a list of preferred vendors for A/V providers. Clients may bring in and/or operate their own equipment or employ a professional. Since we are a rural property, we have limited capabilities and suggest for all presentations to be downloaded in advance and uploaded to a USB or secondary device. We do have a screen & projector available for use.
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FAQ Continued

Animals	We are committed to providing a welcoming environment for all of our visitors and guests. In compliance with the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA) and other relevant legislation, our policy permits the entry of service animals only. For the health and safety of all our patrons, employees and our farm and livestock; pets and other animals are not permitted on Country Heritage Park premises, with the exception of service animals. Service Animals: As defined by the AODA, a service animal is one that is trained to perform tasks for an individual with a disability. These animals are welcome in all areas where members of the public are permitted to go. If it is not immediately obvious, guests may be asked to confirm that the animal is a service animal trained to assist with a disability.
Smoking/Vaping	Smoking and/or vaping is not permitted throughout the property to comply with provincial regulations, with the exception of designated smoking areas.
Coordination Services	Booking parties will have a designated Venue Coordinator to assist them with the planning of their event at Country Heritage Park. This will include all planning related to the venue itself (floorplans, timeline, outline etc.). Although a Venue Coordinator is assigned to your event, we strongly recommend that couples hire a Wedding Coordinator or Wedding Planner to assist on the day of and with any other wedding planning you may need. Our Venue Coordinators are responsible only for the venue itself.
Decoration Restrictions	Open flames such as candles and fires as well as smoke bombs are not permitted at any time in any of the buildings or anywhere on the property. Fines will be issued. Decorators are permitted to use existing fixtures (nails, screws, hooks etc), but may not add any new fastenings. Any and all fasteners such as nails, staples, screws, tape, glue, or any other material that could damage the facility including but not limited to the floor, walls, ceiling and fixtures are not permitted. Straw, hay, paper or plastic confetti are not permitted at any time, anywhere on the property. Couples may choose to include artificial petals (indoor venues only), or rice / real petals (outdoor venues only). Couples who choose to use these celebratory items will be responsible for the cleaning up of these items, or may be charged an additional flat fee for the removal of said celebratory items. Floor wrap vendors must be approved by Country Heritage Park.
Liability	Country Heritage Park holds appropriate liability insurance to host events on its property. However, we strongly recommend that clients purchase their own Party Alcohol Liability (PAL) coverage. Visit: www.palcanada.com
