

## TO BOOK A WEDDING

Verify if the date requested is available by email (rd@rabbidavidgellman.com) or phone 416-300-7218.

Confirm the wedding date with the signing of the contract and a deposit of \$600. Cost for the basic ceremony is \$1200 plus additional fees for:

- Other rituals (eg. hand tying, Bedeken, Ketubah, candle lighting, etc)
- Attendance at rehearsal event and for travel outside Toronto

The couple is to complete a personalized questionnaire to assist the Rabbi in crafting the ceremony, which will lay out among other things:

- Who is in the wedding party
- Vision of the type of ceremony they aspire to have including any readings, rituals, participants
- Extra rituals desired for the ceremony
- A brief statement of their religious/spiritual beliefs
- How the couple met
- If there is anyone they want to have mentioned or honored

First meeting in person is a review of the questionnaire the couple have completed.
