

Booking and Payment

A 25% deposit is required at the time of booking. Full payment is due within 20 business days before the event. Payment can be made by cheque, cash, and E—transfers.

Cancellation

If the event is cancelled prior to 14 days of the event, there will be no financial penalty to the Lessee. Events cancelled within 14 days of the event are subject to a cancellation fee equal to 25% of the room costs. Events cancelled within 5 days of the event are subject to 50% of all rental. Cancellations within 48 hours are subject to 100% of all rental and catering fees. Cancellations will be accepted via phone or email.

Insurance

Proof of events insurance, as outlined in the lease agreement, is required for all events. If you do not have events insurance, insurance can be purchased directly from AON at www.anglican-user.aon.ca.

Alcoholic beverages may only be consumed on the premises with an applicable LCBO permit (Special Occasion Permit), which must be obtained by the Lessee from the LCBO. 















Getting Here by Transit

Using the Subway: the nearest subway station is Osgoode on the Yonge/University line. Walk west on Queen and make a right on John Street.

Using the Dundas streetcar: exit at Beverly and walk south, turning left into the park and follow the path south toward the bell tower.

Using the Queen streetcar: exit at John and walk north one block.

Getting Here by Car

The St. George entrance is on a one-way street running east from Beverly toward McCaul.

From the north: proceed south on Beverly and east (left) on Stephanie.

From the south: proceed north on John and east (right) on Stephanie.

Parking

Due to construction, the church parking lot is inaccessible.

Street parking is available on Stephanie Street and is free on Sundays until 1 p.m.. There is also street parking available on nearby side streets (McCaul, Queen, Beverly and Dundas).

Limited parking is available at Pace Parking Lot, located at 75 McCaul Street.
