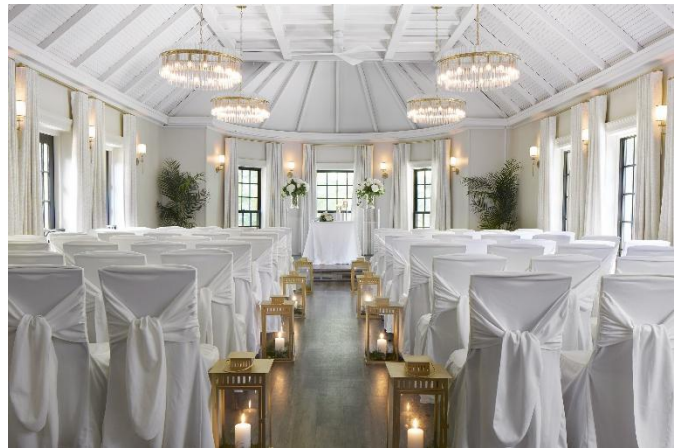




Welcome to the Glenerin Inn & Spa!

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Question: Does the Glenerin Inn & Spa host more than one wedding on any given day or evening?

Answer: In almost every circumstance, there is only either one wedding event during the day or during the evening at the Glenerin Inn & Spa. This allows the wedding party to have exclusive access to our event space, services, and facilities during the time of their event.



Question: Is the venue fee included in the price per person?

Answer: Yes, the venue fee is always included in the price per person at the Glenerin Inn & Spa.

Question: Do wedding parties need to use the Glenerin Inn & Spa preferred vendors or can we select our own?

Answer: It is not a requirement to use the Glenerin Inn & Spa's preferred vendors and there is no additional cost to secure your own preference of vendors. Please keep in mind that our preferred vendors know our facilities and event spaces, have a consistent track record of service and reliability, and are fully accustomed to engaging with wedding parties to make your event a successful one.



Question: Is it possible to have photography of the bridal party taken throughout the property in the public areas and outside around the gardens?

Answer: The Glenerin Inn & Spa permits wedding parties to have photographs taken throughout the public areas and gardens at no cost. There are many picturesque locations to capture that magical moment with a timeless photograph.

Does the Glenerin Inn & Spa provide contingency plans for wedding ceremonies on the outdoor deck in the event of rain?

Answer: The Glenerin Inn & Spa always ensures that a back up indoor event space is reserved for wedding parties who plan to use our outdoor ceremony deck in the event of inclement weather. This gives wedding parties peace of mind to know in advance and timing is coordinated on the day of the ceremony in the event of rain.



Question: I would like to know if my dog can participate in the wedding ceremony.

Answer: One dog is permitted to attend a wedding ceremony at the Glenerin Inn & Spa; however, they must be leashed and under the control of someone belonging to the wedding party. In the event a dog is behaving in a manner not conducive to the wellbeing of all guests, the dog will be required to leave the premises. Please note that due to local health and sanitation regulations, only authorized service dogs may be present during the wedding reception.

Question: Does the Glenerin Inn & Spa provide parking for weddings on the property?

Answer: Parking is not only provided at the Glenerin Inn & Spa, but it is complimentary for all wedding attendees and guests. Parking is available in the main outdoor parking lot, select spaces in an adjacent underground parking lot, and in an auxiliary parking lot for overflow. In the event of a larger event, additional parking can be secured through city parking permit for street parking adjacent the Glenerin Inn & Spa. During busy event days, a parking attendant is stationed in the parking lot to assist and direct guests to the most convenient parking spaces.



Question: For wedding guests, what time is recommended for check-in and check-out.

Answer: During periods of busy activity at the Glenerin Inn & Spa it is recommended to check-in after 3:00pm however special requests can be made for early check-in of any VIP guests with your wedding party, based upon space availability. Every effort will be made to accommodate your valued guests as soon as guestrooms become available and are professionally serviced by our efficient housekeeping team.



For check-out, it is recommended to depart no later than 11:00am to ensure guestrooms may be serviced for same day arrivals. For any late departure requests these may be accommodated for VIP guests based on space availability. Luggage storage is always available after 11:00am along with lunch service in the Dining Room.

Question: Does the Glenerin Inn & Spa provide wireless internet (Wi-Fi) services to wedding guests and is there a cost for this service?

Answer: The Glenerin Inn & Spa provides complimentary Wi-Fi in all areas of the property, public space such as the lobby, lounge, restaurant, outdoor patio, breakfast bar, all five event spaces, including the outdoor wood deck overlooking the Sawmill Valley, and all guestrooms. Wi-Fi is regularly tested to ensure it maintains optimal Mbps speed for usage by valued corporate clients and guests.



Since the Wi-Fi service is open to all guests, it is recommended to use a virtual private network (VPN) of your choice to ensure any confidential data is safe and secure.

Question: There are many guests of my upcoming wedding that have specific dietary needs. Can you accommodate dietary needs for attendees?

Answer: Our executive chef has extensive experience in menus and cuisine to accommodate many dietary needs. These may include gluten free meals, certain food allergies, lactose intolerance, vegan and/or vegetarian cuisine, halal, diabetic friendly, ketogenic, and low-carb diets. Please consult with our catering manager for specific needs and requirements or request an in-person consultation with our executive chef. It is our desire to make sure wedding parties have a safe and enjoyable dining experience with us during their reception. Finally, a complimentary menu tasting is always provided before the wedding to ensure complete satisfaction of our cuisine offerings!



Question: Does the Glenerin Inn & Spa have any wedding venue spaces that have natural outdoor lighting and/or access to outdoor space?

Answer: The Glenerin Inn & Spa's unique historical building has natural outdoor lighting in all five event spaces. This feature brings a bright and serene setting to your wedding ceremony and reception in contrast to many hotels that feature only four wall event space. Moreover, several of our event spaces offer walk-out door access to outdoor settings. These walk-out areas provide access to our outdoor patio with a view of the Sawmill Valley or to a patio overlooking to main entrance gardens, all of which are conveniently located on the main floor. Alternatively, there is also a large wooden deck overlooking the Sawmill Valley which is a favorite for wedding ceremonies.



Question: Does the Glenerin Inn & Spa have any activities or destinations nearby the property?

Answer: The Glenerin Inn & Spa has a professionally operated full-service spa on property that offers many different spa treatments for wedding parties. These include spa and body treatments, skin care, hand, nail, and foot care, and more. 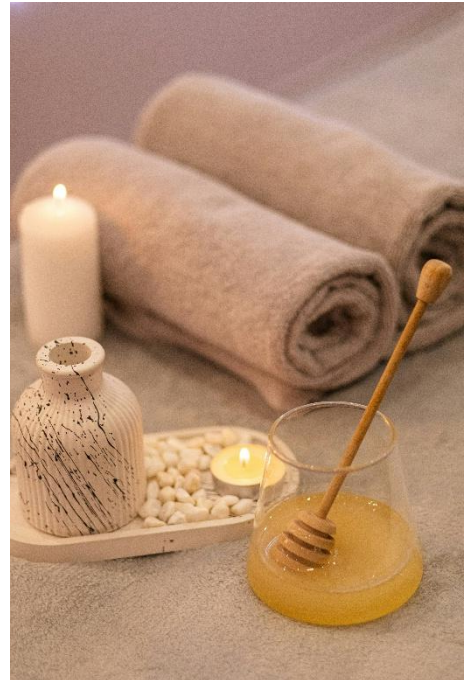
The Glenerin Inn & Spa is also adjacent to the Sawmill Valley and there are many outdoor nature trails accessible just a short distance from our property. Experience a brisk walk out in a forest-like setting to refresh yourself.

For golf enthusiasts, two notable and renowned golf clubs are nearby with the Mississauga Golf and Country Club and the Credit Valley Golf and Country Club.

The Riverwood Conservancy is a short drive away from the Glenerin Inn & Spa and provides an oasis of woodlands, meadows, ravines, and gardens, which span 150 acres along with Credit Valley River in Mississauga. Heading south towards Lake Ontario, Rattray Marsh Conservation Area is also a beautiful and serene destination for an outing in nature. Further information may be obtained from their websites.

For shopping enthusiasts, Mississauga is host to three shopping malls, Square One, Sherway Gardens, and Erin Mills Town Centre, all of which are within driving distance from the Glenerin Inn & Spa. Other nearby activities include the extensive Ontario Racquet Club for tennis enthusiasts. For other outside dining options and boardwalk strolls, consider the Port Credit area located right on Lake Ontario.
